

Darko Bohnec, vicegovernor of Banka Slovenije, Slovenia



Darko Bohnec spent five years at the Ministry of Finance of Slovenia, following his graduation at Ljubljana University with a BA in Economics in 1980. In 1985, he joined Banka Slovenije. He had managed two departments: the Analysis and Research Department from 1988 to 1992 and the Central Banking Operations from 1994 until 1998, when he took up his current position as Vice Governor. He is currently responsible for banking operations, payment systems and cash management. He was Chairman of the Monetary and Exchange Rate Policy Committee in the Bank of Slovenia between 2004 and the end of 2006. He was heading the Slovenian delegation for the IMF Article IV missions in years 2000 – 2004.

Darko Bohnec was a member of the National Coordination Committee for the Euro adoption during the years 2005 and 2006. He is currently the member of International Relations Committee at ESCB.
