

Paweł Samecki, member of the management board of the National Bank of Poland, Poland



Paweł Samecki was born in 1958 in Lodz. In 1981 he completed his studies at the Department of Economy and Sociology of the University of Lodz. In 1988 he obtained a Doctoral Degree in Economics (international economic relations at the University of Lodz). In the years 1981-1990 he was employed as a researcher (as a research assistant and later adjunct professor) at his original Department. In 1990 he pursued an annual internship at the London School of Economics.

In 1991-1996 he was Director of the Office for Foreign Assistance at the office of the Government Plenipotentiary for European Integration and Foreign Assistance. In 1997-1998 he was Under-Secretary at the Ministry of Finance. From the first half of 1998 until January 2002 he was Under-Secretary at the Office of the Committee for European Integration. In the period of February 2002 - March 2003 he was research project coordinator at the European Centre Natolin.

He is an author of two book publications and numerous research and popular scientific articles. He has been awarded with the Medal of the National Education Committee.
